THE 8TH HYDROPOWER FOR TODAY FORUM: HYDROPOWER PROMOTES INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT IN AFRICA, 6–7 NOVEMBER 2018, LUSAKA, ZAMBIA

We have the pleasure to announce that the global hydropower promotion event, the 8th Hydropower for Today Forum, will be held in Lusaka, Zambia on 6 – 7 November 2018. The forum, whose theme is 'Hydropower Promotes Industrial Development in Africa', will be coorganized by the Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa (COMESA) and the International Center on Small Hydro Power (ICSHP), Hangzhou, People's Republic of China.

The deadline for the submission of abstracts is the 10th October 2018, the follow-up full papers of up to 6000 words will be required by 25 October 2018, and further formatting guidelines will be sent to all authors whose papers are accepted.
